

COMMUNICATION FROM YACHTING VICTORIA

Yachting Victoria has two main e-newsletter communications with its members – both

1. member clubs and their officials
2. individuals who are members of clubs

Each of these membership groups receive a different monthly e-newsletter, normally in the last week of the month.

Yachting Victoria no longer normally mails hard copy letters or information.

Each e-newsletter's objective is to communicate new relevant information in summary, and direct interested readers to the source of more detailed information – often the Yachting Victoria website.

To receive these e-newsletters you must

1. To receive the CLUB OFFICIAL Newsletter – be registered as a Club Official on the MyClub database AND have an accurate email address. The Club Newsletter will cover all matters relevant to Club Officials only. The updating of MyClub can only be done by your trusted club official who has a password.
2. To receive the INDIVIDUAL Member Newsletter – you must be registered on the Yachting Australia database as a club member AND have an accurate email address on it. If you do not receive the current newsletter you need to use MySailor to
 - a. Check that your membership is registered with Yachting Australia
 - b. Check your email address is correct.To do this in MySailor simply use your YA number (Silver Card) and password as mailed to you with your YA card (Silver Card).

Note

- Individual sailors may also receive email newsletters directly from Yachting Australia.
- Sailing School Principals and Instructors registered in MyCentre will occasionally receive Training related e-newsletters
